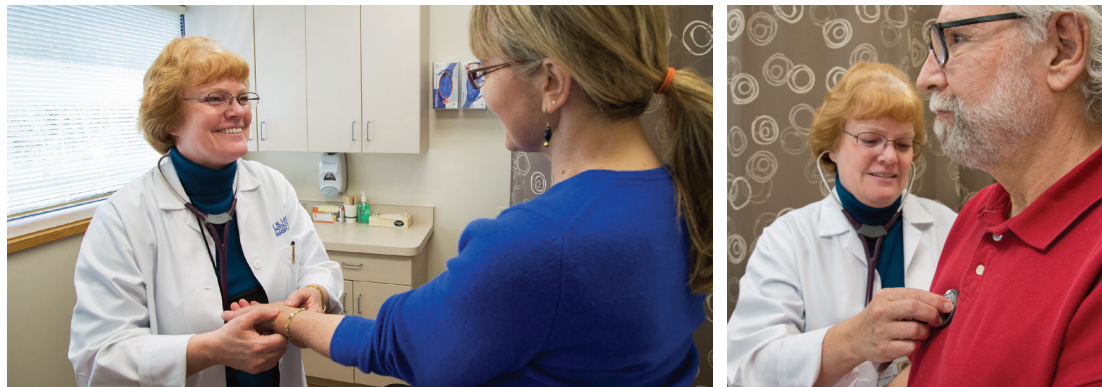


NORTHWEST MEDICAL SPECIALTIES - HEPATOLOGY
