WHEREAS, HCA and Contractor previously entered into an Agreement for the Contractor to support the statewide goal of implementing evidence-based practices in the community mental health system, and;

WHEREAS, HCA and Contractor wish to amend the Agreement pursuant to Section 6, *Agreement Changes, Modifications and Amendments,* to increase funding to eliminate out of pocket costs for participants in the CBT plus trainings and to ensure dedicated topics of substance use are included in the training;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Section 4, *Payment*, is amended to read as follows:

Compensation for the work provided in accordance with this Agreement has been established under the terms of RCW 39.34.130. The parties have determined that the cost of accomplishing the work herein will not exceed **\$288,775**. Payment for satisfactory performance of the work will not exceed this amount unless the parties mutually agree to a higher amount. Compensation for services will be based on the following rates or in accordance with the terms as set forth in accordance with Schedule A, *Statement of Work - TFCBT / CBT+ Training & Consultation Services*, Section 3, *Deliverables*.

2. Schedule A, *Statement of Work – TFCBT/CBT+ Training & Consultation Services*, purpose statement is amended to read as follows:

The Contractor shall provide the services and staff, and otherwise do all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of this work, as set forth below.

Cognitive Behavioral Therapy-Plus (CBT+) will require participants to pay \$100.00 to contribute to support for the training. The purpose of this fee is to build a sustainable and expanded model with contributions from multiple sources, including provider organizations, the state, and other sources.

3. Schedule A, *Statement of Work – TFCBT/CBT+ Training & Consultation Services*, Section 1, *Coordination and Facilitation*, is amended to read as follows:

The Contractor shall coordinate and facilitate ongoing training and technical assistance in CBT+, including use of the Evidence Based Practices (EBP) Toolkit and three-hour UMU Asynchronous Training Format and provide ongoing training and technical assistance to Community Mental Health Agencies (CMHA). Training will also contain relevant curricula for those with co-occurring SUD and Mental Health issues by reviewing current curricula and including SUD specific examples. Training shall include:

- 4. This Amendment will be effective as of the last date of signature show below ("Effective Date").
- 5. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the meaning ascribed to them in the Contract.
- 6. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
