World-Class Imaging- High-Tech with a Human Touch

Diagnostic imaging — from the equipment and technologists, to the radiologists who read the images — is crucial to providing accurate diagnoses which lead to exceptional patient care. The UW Medicine Eastside Specialty Center offers a broad range of radiology and imaging services, utilizing state-of-the-art technology including:

- ultra-low dose computer tomography (CT) in high resolution,
- large bore direct-digital magnetic resonance (MR) with all surface coils,
- direct-digital radiography (a plain film X-ray) with tomosynthesis, and
- 3-D and 4-D ultrasound.

We also offer the *only* ultra-low dose radiology services on the eastside. The ultra-low dose CT lowers patient radiation exposure by up to 80 percent while maintaining image clarity, at no additional cost. Direct-digital plain film radiography is the lowest dose available for a patient.

Each exam is double-read by at least two different radiologists, who are highly sub-specialized in their respective discipline, such as musculoskeletal, abdominal, or neuroradiology. Radiology and Imaging Services' electronic records (Picture Archiving and Communication System — PACS) offer physician's offices immediate access to images from any study. Interpretative reports are available within two hours routinely but within a few minutes when requested.
