

UW Transportation Services Resources for Housestaff

Residents and Fellows Transportation 1-2-3

We can provide you with U-PASS, parking permits for the UW main campus and UW's South Lake Union campus, and access to high security bike parking. Note that other campuses require their own parking passes and you will need to obtain those passes from each campus' provider.

*To purchase U-PASS or enroll in Pay Per Use Parking, you will need: your Employee ID number, a Husky Card, and you must be on payroll.

1. U-PASS Membership

- U-PASS membership gives you full-fare coverage on nearly all Puget Sound public transit (including bus, light rail, commuter train). It costs \$50/month.
- Purchase U-PASS membership through payroll deduction at <https://transportation.uw.edu/netid/u-pass/employee-signup>

*It will take 24-48 hours after enrolling before you can use your U-PASS to pay for transit fare.

2. Vehicle Registration

- All permit holders must have vehicle registration on file.
- Register your vehicle at <https://transportation.uw.edu/netid/register-vehicle>

*You will need your name, NetID, employee number, and year, make, and model of each vehicle you plan to drive. You will also need a photo of your license plate or vehicle registration for each vehicle.

3. Pay Per Use Parking (PPUP)

- PPUP allows you to park as little or as much as you like—you only get charged on days that you park. Rates are:
\$8.40 per day

*Once registered, you can park in the Portage Bay Garage parking lot by simply swiping your Husky Card at the entrance of the facility.

*You can email ucommute@uw.edu to be placed on the waitlist for E12.

*You can also request an out-of-area permit from any campus gatehouse (lot assignment subject to availability) at the same PPUP rates.

*If you leave a PPUP area and re-enter the same day, you will not be charged twice.
