This Contract between the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and the Contractor is hereby amended as follows:

Effective April 1, 2022

1. The Maximum Contract Amount is increased by **\$68,738.10** for the current contract year, to a new Maximum Contract Amount of **\$137,550.10**.
2. Special Terms and Conditions, Section 4, Statement of Work is replaced with the following language:

4. Statement of Work

The Contractor shall provide the services and staff, and otherwise do all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of work, as set forth below:

- h. Provide pediatric nursing support to include the following:
 - (1) Triage pediatric questions that come to International Clinic nurse's warm line that relate to pediatrics
 - (2) Utilize clinic judgment about individual, family, or community resources and response to actual or potential health problems
 - (3) Identify nursing priorities and directs patients and families to community-based interventions
 - (4) Assess coping and resources for families afflicted by traumatic stress
 - (5) Complete clinical intake for complex referrals via phone call/ telemedicine, document problem lists, medications, and needs
 - (6) Provide clinical instruction and support as needed by families
 - (7) Serve as the primary RN contact for clinical triage and management calls for RHPP patients (respond to clinic calls, calls from specialists, etc), manage nursing response to complex medical concerns identified by patients, nurses, or providers
 - (8) Create individual care plan for each RHPP patient
 - (9) Interpret family and past medical history, current symptoms and pediatric medical diagnoses to identify educational, care coordination, or community referral needs of refugee children
 - (10) Facilitate and lead team care coordination meetings with PCP, specialist, schools, therapy social work and dieticians
 - (11) Order and teach DME use
 - (12) Coordinate pediatric record gathering for case management
 - (13) Lead RHPP high risk team meetings with primary care providers

- (14) Provide ongoing care coordination with subspecialists and community agencies
- i. Provide pediatric physician administrative support to include the following:
 - (1) Supervise and assist pediatric RN case manager with triage and ongoing complex medical care of new refugee pediatric patients
 - (2) Triage new referrals and develop triage assessment plans for pediatric patients
 - (3) Provide clinical consultation for resettlement agency staff (includes refugee resettlement organizations, sponsor circles, etc.)
 - (4) Provide ongoing advocacy and support for patients enrolled in the RHPP program
 - (5) Assist in connection of refugee families to medical specialists and primary care providers
 - (6) Create sustainable and equitable systems for referral and care navigation for refugee families.

3. Special Terms and Conditions, Section 5, Consideration is replaced with the following language:

5. Consideration

- a. Total consideration payable to Contractor for satisfactory performance of the work under this Contract is up to a maximum of **\$137,550.10**, including any and all expenses, the amended amount of **\$68,738.10** will be billed on a separate A19 and will be paid as follows:

(1) FFY 2022 (April 1, 2022 – September 30, 2022)

- i. \$11,456.35 per month for services outlined in the Statement of Work and submission of the monthly Participant Services Report for the period of April 2022 through September 30, 2022.

All other terms and conditions of this Contract remain in full force and effect.
